Day 1: Arrival

Welcome to Marrakech! Your driver will pick you up at the airport and drop at the hotel.

About your hotel: [Riad Marana](#)



2 minutes from the place Jemaa El Fna in the heart of the old medina of Marrakech in the district Laqsour, discover the Riad Maranna.

This property filled with charm and authenticity opens the various craft shops and souks.

This Riad offers 5 rooms with private lounges and bathrooms tadelakt different and finely decorated. A lounge where you can enjoy all the Moroccan traditions, pastillas, tagines, or enjoy the atmosphere and read a book from the library.

The terrace on the other hand, offers a view of the Koutoubia and Djemaa el F'na. The evening, let yourself in an atmosphere of a thousand and one nights with the cool nights Moroccan lights and rays lanterns.

Day 2: Marrakech - High Atlas - Ait Ben Haddou Kasbah - Ouarzazate - Dadés Valley

Pick up from your accommodation in Marrakech at 8 o'clock in the morning and depart to the High Atlas, subrange of Moroccan Atlas mountains, going through Tizi N´Tichka port with stops for panoramic views and taking pictures of the Berber small villages that camouflage in the landscape.

Then we continue south to the ksar (fortified village) of Ait Ben Haddou where we will visit the famous Kasbah (declared World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1986). Famous films have been shot in this spectacular stage, including *Gladiator*, *Obelix*, *The Mummy*, *The Jewel of the Nile*, *Sahara* with Penélope Cruz, etc.



Lunch in town.

Then we continue to Ouarzazate also known as “The gate of the desert” that in berber language means “noiseless or without confusion”. Here we´ll see the Taourirt kasbah, one of the most spectacular ksars in Morocco.



The next site to visit is the Rose Valley going through the big Skoura palm grove; a beautiful place to contemplate more than 700.000 palms and numerous kasbahs that are built in the surrounding area. In this Valley damascenes roses are raised for cosmetic use such as the valued rosewater. The Rose Festival is held here annually in May, it is an important moussem for Moroccan culture.

Finally we reach the Dades valley where we´ll spend the night.

About your hotel: [Hotel Babylon Dades](#)

Offering a restaurant, Hotel Babylon Dades is located in Imdiazen.



Each room here will provide you with air conditioning, a balcony and a terrace. Shared bathroom also comes with a shower. You can enjoy mountain view and river view from the room. Extras include a washing machine and a fireplace.

At Hotel Babylon Dades you will find a 24-hour front desk, a terrace and a shared kitchen. Other facilities offered at the property include a shared lounge, luggage storage and dry cleaning. An array of activities can be enjoyed on site or in the surroundings, including cycling and a water park.

Day 3: Dadés Valley - Todra Gorges - Merzouga Dunes - Camel ride and night in desert

After breakfast we'll enjoy one of the most beautiful views of the Dadés Valley from one strategic lookout in the mountains, from there we can

appreciate the great number of kasbahs and the scenic characteristics of each one.

A very good asphalt road leads up the valley from the city of Tinerhir to the gorge and then to the desert.

After some stops on the way we'll reach the Todra Gorges. The scenery is spectacular. Local people live in the area and can be seen in their adobe villages. Thanks to its rock sides with many uneven surfaces, these gorges are popular among rock climbers.



After a short walk in the Todra gorges you'll have free time for lunch in Tinejdad or Touroug and then we continue our way to the desert to reach the spectacular dunes of Merzouga.



We'll take there a camel ride of one hour to our nomad camp located in the middle of a sea of dunes (Erg Chebbi). Before dinner we'll see the sunset at the top of a dune for then sleep in a tent under a beautiful starry sky.

About your accommodation: [Sahara Stars Camp](#)

With Camel Trekking Sahara Tour reachable in 1.4 km, Sahara Stars Camp offers accommodation, a restaurant, a bar, ski-to-door access and barbecue facilities. Free WiFi is offered.

There is a private bathroom with bath and a hairdryer in each unit, along with free toiletries.

A continental breakfast is available every morning at the tented camp.

Sahara Stars Camp offers a sun terrace.

Skiing and cycling can be enjoyed nearby, while a ski equipment rental service and a ski pass sales point are also available on site.



Flamingo Birdwatching is 3.7 km from the accommodation, while Lake Daya Tamezguidat/Flamingo is 3.8 km from the property.

Day 4: Merzouga Desert - Ziz Valley - Cedar forests and monkey troupes of Azrou - Ifrane - Fes

This is a complete Desert day.

“Date with the sunrise” If you are In the middle of the desert, it’s absolutely worth getting up early to contemplate the most spectacular sunrise you’ve ever seen at the top of a dune close to the camp and enjoy this landscape that is a gift of nature.

After sunrise we return to Merzouga on the camels where a hearty breakfast is waiting for us.

After, we start our day to the north through the Tafilalet palm grove, the biggest in the world. You'll see thousands of palm trees along the 20km of road. This way leads us to the Ziz valley, which river comes down from the high Atlas and feeds the palm grove. Here we make a stop and from this high viewpoint, enjoy a magnificent view of the valley and the town of Aoufous.

We make another stop in Midelt, just in the heart of the Atlas where you'll have free time for lunch and rest for a while.



In the afternoon we continue our way through the Cedar Woods where, if we are lucky, we'll see some monkeys. The next place we'll visit is the city of Ifrane, situated in the northwestern slope of the Middle Atlas at 1630 meters above the water level. Its broad avenues, its urban development with perfect

cleanness, the gardens, the green areas and its architecture make this city look like a swiss town. Ifrane feels misplaced in Morocco. That's why it's named the Moroccan Switzerland, and if that's not enough it has an important ski resort, Michlifen.

Riad Mazar features air-conditioned rooms with satellite flat-screen TV in the Fes El Bali district of Fès. Among the facilities of this property are a restaurant, a 24-hour front desk and a shared lounge, along with free WiFi.



The property is non-smoking and is set 2.3 km from Royal Palace Fes.

At the guest house, rooms are equipped with a wardrobe. All rooms are fitted with a private bathroom with a shower, a hairdryer and free toiletries.

Guests at Riad Mazar can enjoy a continental breakfast.

The accommodation offers a terrace.

Day 5 : Fez – Chefchaouen



Departure from Fez to Chefchaouen, through Ouezzane, a town located on the southern edge of the Rif Mountains. The journey is filled with rolling and fertile slopes, lush with olive trees. Arrive in Chefchaouen, settle in your accommodation and relax after your journey.

Located in Chefchaouene, a few steps from Kasba, Riad Hicham provides air-conditioned rooms with free WiFi. Featuring a 24-hour front desk, this property also has a restaurant and a terrace. The property is non-smoking and is set a few steps from Outa El Hammam Square.



Guest rooms at the riad are equipped with a seating area, a flat-screen TV with cable channels and a private bathroom with free toiletries and a bath. The units include a wardrobe.

Guests at Riad Hicham can enjoy a halal breakfast.

Mohammed 5 Square is less than 1 km from the accommodation, while Khandak Semmar is 1.8 km away. The nearest airport is Sania Ramel Airport, 68 km from Riad Hicham.

Day 6 : Chafchaouen – Rabat – Casablanca

At 8 AM you will start your trip from the visit of the biggest mosque in Casablanca, Hassan II mosque.



Also, the sightseeing tour and after that, you will go to the capital of Morocco “Rabat”. We will start with the Bad challah, Mausoleum of Mohammed V and one of the main gates of the royal palace and the Oudaya Kasbah.

Lunch in a local restaurant.

Then we drive straight to Chefchaouen -the blue city. On the way you will pass through many small towns and nice views we will try to be there little bit early to enjoy that evening in the city Casablanca.
